Description			
1) graphics export is broken on Ubuntu			
- currently on my TXM the default export format for graphics is 'svg' - when I call the 'Export graphic' command on an AFC factorial plane, the file selector dialog box opens with: - a file name with extension set to '.svg' - a current "format" set to '*.svg' in the down right pull down menu - if I change the "format" to any other value, for example '*.png' : - a) the file extension is not changed -> it should be edited to the extension chosen - b) BUG the format is still SVG -> it should be set to the format corresponding to the extension chosen			
Solution 1			
The GTK dialog doesn't work well. A first workaround is to use only the extension the user has set in the file name + check if the extension is managed by TXM.			
Solution 2
